Sponsorship

Platinum Sponsorship

Platinum sponsor contributes to the conference as much as € 5,000. In offer, the platinum sponsor will receive the following facilities:

2. One A-4 advertisement page in the conference proceeding (see **Annex 1**). This advertisement page is directly placed after the promotional paper (see point 1). Should there be enough budget, the conference proceeding is also planned to be distributed to the libraries of main universities in Europe and Indonesia.
3. Sponsor’s name and logo on the cover page of the conference proceeding (see **Annex 1**) and the conference website (see **Annex 2**)
4. A right to distribute flyer and brochure during the conference.
5. A right to display the promotional video for 10 minutes during the lunch or dinner breaks for up to 10 minutes.
6. Maximum number of delegation 3 persons (including one person for paper presentation)

Gold Sponsorship

Gold sponsor contributes to the conference as much as € 3,000. In offer, the gold sponsor will receive the following facilities:

1. One A-4 advertisement page in the conference proceeding (see **Annex 1**). Should there be enough budget, the conference proceeding is also planned to be distributed to the libraries of main universities in Europe and Indonesia.
2. Sponsor's name and logo on the conference website (see **Annex 2**).
3. A right to distribute flyer and brochure during the conference.
4. A right to display the promotional video for 10 minutes during the lunch or dinner breaks for up to 10 minutes.
5. Maximum number of delegation 2 persons.

Sponsorship Procedure and Regulation

1. The sponsorship agreement should be submitted on 22nd May 2010 at the latest.
2. The conference committee will limit the number of platinum sponsorships of 5 companies. When there are already 5 platinum sponsorships, the conference committee cannot accept other platinum sponsorships.
3. The conference committee will limit the number of gold sponsorship of 10 companies. When there are already 10 platinum sponsorships, the conference committee cannot accept other sponsorships.
4. If a company A submit the platinum (or gold) sponsorship earlier than company B, the company A has in a priority to decide:
 - the location of name and logo of the company in the cover page of conference proceeding (only for platinum sponsor, see **Annex 1**)
 - the location of paper (only for platinum sponsor) and the advertisement page in the conference proceeding (for platinum and gold sponsors, see **Annex 1**)
 - the location of name and logo of the company in the conference website (for platinum and gold sponsors, see **Annex 2**)
5. The sponsor should transfer the down-payment and the final-payment as stated in payment procedure.
6. The company's logo should be submitted after the down-payment is settled. The company's paper should be submitted as written in the submission guidelines. The company's advertisement (1 page A-4) should be submitted on 7th August 2010 at the latest.

7. Should the sponsor cancel the agreement, the down-payment which have been given to the committee will not be given back.
8. All regulation can be reduced or added with an agreement of both parties, i.e. the conference committee and the sponsor.
9. After signed and sealed by the sponsor, the letter of sponsorship agreement should be send to the following address:

Sponsorship Payment

1. The sponsor should accomplish the down-payment, which is 30% from total payment, on 2nd July 2010 at the latest.
2. The final-payment, which is 30% from total payment, should be transferred to the conference committee on 6th August 2010 at the latest.
3. Should the sponsorship be cancelled before 16th July, the committee will transfer the down-payment back. Should the sponsorship be cancelled after 16th July 2010, the committee will retain the down-payment. Should the conference be cancelled, the committee will re-transfer all sponsorship payment which has been transferred by the sponsor.

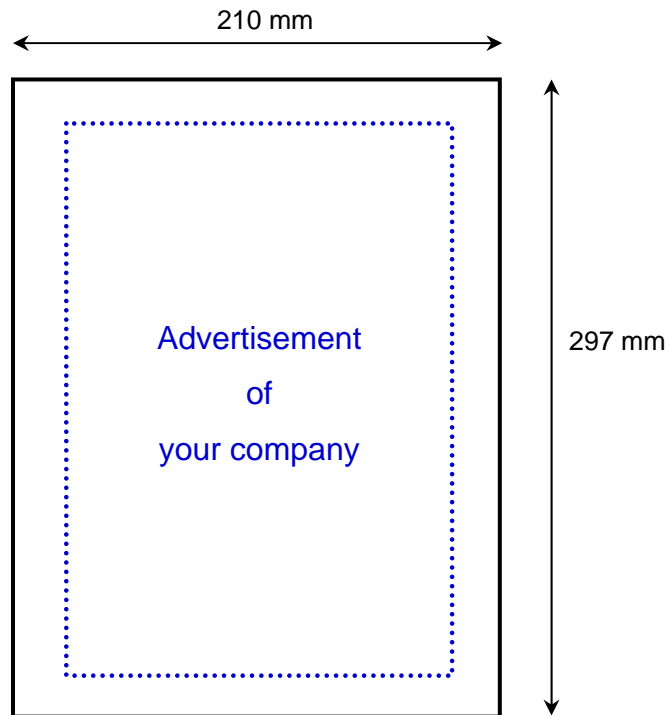
